Selection Process

Shortlisted candidates will be contacted via phone or email and invited to attend an **interview** and **psychometric testing** at the Hillary Construction Head Office in **Polokwane**. If you do not receive any feedback, please consider your application unsuccessful.

Eligibility Criteria

To apply for the **Hillary Construction Bursary Programme**, you must meet the following criteria:

- South African Citizen or Permanent Resident: You must be a South African citizen or a permanent resident.
- Matric Completion: You must have completed Matric with an exemption certificate.
- **Current Studies**: You must be studying towards a **National Diploma or Degree** in one of the eligible fields (Civil Engineering, Quantity Surveying, Surveying).
- Accredited Institution: You must be enrolled at a recognized and accredited University or University of Technology in South Africa.
- Matric Results:
 - University students must have achieved a minimum C symbol for Mathematics and Science in Matric.
 - University of Technology students must have achieved a minimum **D** symbol for **Mathematics** and **Science** in Matric.
- **Current Academic Performance**: You must have achieved a minimum **65% overall average** in your current studies.
