Minimum Requirements

To qualify, applicants must:

- Be unemployed
- Not be registered for any qualification or other learnership
- Have Matric (Grade 12) with English and a minimum Level 4 in all subjects
- Be a South African citizen with a valid SA ID
- Be between 18 and 30 years of age
- Not be PSIRA registered
- Have no criminal record
- Demonstrate excellent communication skills
- Computer literacy in MS Office, email, and internet is an added advantage
- Be able to work independently and show initiative
- Reside close to Strand

For People with Disabilities (PWDs)

Applicants with disabilities must submit proof of disability, such as:

- A Doctor's Certificate/report, or
- A signed ITRDD13 form by a registered medical doctor
