 - o Minimum 60% in Mathematics (NOT Maths Literacy)
 - o Minimum 60% in English
- 1st Year Students (applying for 2nd year in 2026):
 - o Minimum 60% in Financial Accounting
 - o Minimum 60% in Matric Mathematics & English
- 2nd Year Students (applying for 3rd year in 2026):
 - Minimum 60% in Financial Accounting & Management Accounting
- Final Year Students (postgraduate in 2026):
 - Minimum 55% in all core modules
 - Must have CTA acceptance
